Microsoft Word is the preferred format for notice submissions. Please do not send notices only in PDF format as errors may occur when converting to Word. Image files should be sent in JPG or PNG format.

Therefore, please send all notice submissions in the Microsoft Word format and a PDF version of such Notice only where there are signatures to be included in the notice submission (document). This applies to all institutions including governmental, financial and other commercial institutions. Additionally, for the security purposes of any financial information being sent, the institution's Information Technology (IT) personnel can lock the information as a JPEG in a Microsoft Word document and send the information to the Editor in that prescribed manner.

The Gazette Department reserves the right to apply its in-house style to all notices. Any corrections which are related to style will be made at the discretion of the Editor for reasons of consistency.

The deadline for submitting notices for publication in the principal edition is midday Monday on every week for all commercial and Government notices, in the week of publication.


STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

2020, No. 19

Proclamation dated the 25th day of March 2020, declaring a state of public emergency in accordance with section 20(1) of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda Cap. 23.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 20(1) of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda, Cap. 23 that the Governor General may, by proclamation which shall be published in the Official Gazette, declare that a state of public emergency exists for the purposes of Chapter II of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda, Cap. 23;

AND WHEREAS section 21(5) of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda, Cap. 23 provides that a proclamation under section 20 shall not be effective unless it contains a declaration that the Governor General is satisfied –

(a) that a public emergency has arisen as a result of the imminence of a state of war between Her Majesty and a foreign state or as a result of the occurrence of any earthquake, hurricane, flood, fire, outbreak of pestilence or of infectious disease, or other calamity whether similar to the foregoing or not; or

(b) that action has been taken, or is immediately threatened, by any person, of such a nature and on so extensive a scale, as to be likely to endanger the public safety or to deprive the community or any substantial portion of the community of supplies or services essential to life;

AND WHEREAS a public emergency has arisen as a result of the Coronavirus 2019 an infectious disease more commonly known as COVID-19;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS KCN, GCMG, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, by this Proclamation do hereby declare –

- (a) that a state of public emergency exists for the purposes of Chapter II of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda, Cap. 23;
- (b) that I am satisfied that a public emergency has arisen as a result of the occurrence of the Coronavirus 2019 more commonly known as COVID-19, which has been declared as a dangerous infectious disease.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Antigua and Barbuda at Government House in the City of Saint John, in the State of Antigua and Barbuda this 25th day of March, 2020 in the Sixty-ninth year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second.

GIVEN at the Governor General’s Residence, St. John’s, Antigua this 25th day of March, 2020 and in the Sixty-ninth year of Her Majesty’s Reign
