Price Control (Items essential for the prevention of COVID-19) Order, made by the Minister under section 3 of the Distribution and Prices of Goods Act, Cap. 138.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Price Control (Items essential for the prevention of COVID-19) Order, 2022.

2. Maximum wholesale price markup for items essential for the prevention of COVID-19

The percentages quoted in the third column of the Schedule are the fixed and declared maximum wholesale price markup for the corresponding commodity listed in column 1 of the Schedule that may be sold by wholesalers throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Maximum retail price markup for items essential for the prevention of COVID-19

The percentages quoted in the fourth column of the Schedule are the fixed and declared maximum retail price markup for the corresponding commodity listed in column 1 of the Schedule that may be sold by retailers throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

4. Offence and penalty

- (1) A person shall not sell any commodity listed in the Schedule at a price greater than the maximum price markup fixed and declared in the Schedule.
- (2) Any person who contravenes sub-paragraph 1 commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding three months.
