BC TIMBER SALES ACCOUNT REGULATION

Payment out of BC Timber Sales Account

- 1 For the purposes of section 109 (3) (e) of the [Forest Act](#), money in the BC Timber Sales Account may be expended for a purpose related to an agreement, between the government and a holder of a licence or agreement referred to in section 61 (1) of the [Forest Act](#), respecting a reduction under that section of the allowable annual cut authorized in or for the licence or agreement to make timber available for disposition under
 - (a) a timber sales licence entered into under section 20 of the [Forest Act](#),
 - (b) a forestry licence to cut entered into under section 47.6 (3) of the [Forest Act](#), or
 - (c) a road permit granted for a licence referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) to the licence holder,to persons other than the holder of the licence or agreement referred to in section 61 (1) of the [Forest Act](#).
