Interpretation

1 (1) In this regulation:

"**Act**" means the [Forest Act](#);

"**bundle tag**" means a durable and waterproof tag showing a unique

(a) identification number, or

(b) combination of numbers and letters;

"**scale site**" means a place for which a scale site authorization issued under the Act is in effect;

"**timber**" means trees, whether living, dead, limbed, bucked or neeled, and includes special forest products:
