Part 1 — General

Definitions and interpretation

1 (1) In this regulation:

- "2 point buck"** means a male deer having an antler composed of a main beam from which no more than 2 tines, each of which is at least 2.5 cm in length not including the brow tine or basal burr, project beyond the lower third of the main beam;
- "3 point buck"** means a male deer having an antler composed of a main beam from which no more than 3 tines, each of which is at least 2.5 cm in length not including the brow tine or basal burr, project beyond the lower third of the main beam;
- "3 point bull elk"** means an elk having an antler composed of a main beam from which 3 or more tines project, each of which is at least 2.5 cm in length;
- "3 point bull moose"** means a moose having 2 antlers from each of which 3 or more tines project, each of which is more than 2.5 cm in length;
- "4 point buck"** means a male deer having an antler composed of a main beam from which 4 or more tines, not including the brow tine, project, each of which is at least 2.5 cm in length;
- "5 point bull caribou"** means a caribou having an antler which bears at least 5 tines, including the tip of the main beam above the rear point, each of which is at least 2.5 cm in length;
- "5 point bull elk"** means an elk having an antler composed of a main beam from which 5 or more tines project, each of which is more than 2.5 cm long;
- "6 point bull elk"** means an elk having an antler composed of a main beam from which 6 or more tines project, each of which is greater than 2.5 cm in length;
- "adult grizzly bear"** means a grizzly bear that is older than 2 years;
- "adult mountain goat"** means a mountain goat with horns that are greater than 76 mm in length;
