Egg Product Regulation

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Interpretation

1 In this regulation:

"Act" means the [Agricultural Produce Grading Act](#);

"dried egg" means whole egg, egg yolk or egg white in dried form;

"egg" means an egg

- (a) of the domestic hen belonging to the species *Gallus domesticus*,
- (b) of the domestic turkey belonging to the species *Meleagris gallopavo*, or
- (c) of the domestic duck belonging to the species *Anas platyrhynchos*,

but does not include an egg whether wholly or partly formed that has been removed from a slaughtered bird;

"egg product" means frozen egg, liquid egg, dried egg or a mix;

"egg product station" means a place where egg product is graded, packed and marked and in respect of which a certificate of registration has been issued under the [Canada Agricultural Products Act](#);
