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Regulation title

1 This regulation may be cited as the "Domestic Bacterial Ring Rot Regulation".

Definitions

2 In this regulation, unless the context otherwise requires:

- "Act" means the [Plant Protection Act](#);
- "grower" means any person occupying land for the purpose of producing potatoes;
- "inspector" means an inspector appointed under the Act;
- "plant pathologist" means a plant pathologist authorized by the minister.
