Blueberry Maggot Control Regulation

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Interpretation

- 1 In this regulation:
- "blueberry maggot" means *Rhagoletis mendax* Curran;
- "infested area" means any place listed in the Schedule or any other place where blueberry maggot is known to be established;
- "inspector" means an inspector appointed under the authority of the [Ministry of Agriculture and Food Act](#).

Quarantine area established

- 2 To prevent the spread within the Province of blueberry maggot, the Province is declared to be a quarantine area.

Movement of fresh blueberries into the quarantine area

- 3 No person shall move fresh blueberries into the quarantine area from an infested area unless
- (a) the blueberries have been fumigated with methyl bromide at atmospheric pressure in accordance with one of the following:
