1. These Rules may be cited as the

Short title.

FORESTS (AMENDMENT) RULES 1997,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Forests Rules hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules.

- 2. The principal Rules are hereby amended by the addition of the following new rule immediately after rule 42:-
- Addition of new rule 42A.
- "42A. (1) Nothwithstanding the provisions contained in rule 42, Breadnut (Brosimum alicastrum) shall be allowed to be felled where this tree species is included in the approved yield of a sustained yield licence, as defined under Rule 5(1)(a) of these rules.
- (2) Felling of this tree shall not be allowed under any other type of licence.

(3) The minimum felling girth shall be 72 inches and the royalty rate for this species shall be \$0.30 per cubic foot (true cylindrical volume under bark)."
