THE ACT ON AMENDEMENTS TO THE ACT ON BIOCIDAL PRODUCTS

Article 1

The word: »transit« is deleted from Article 2 item 20 of the Act on Biocidal Products (Official Gazette 63/07).

Article 2

In Article 3 paragraph 1 subparagraph 1, after the words: »medical aids« a coma is inserted and is followed by the words: »in vitro diagnostic medical aids«.

Article 3

In Article 54 paragraph 2, the word: »decision« is replaced by the word: »ordinance«.

Article 4

In Article 59 paragraph 1, item 2 is deleted.

Article 5

In Article 60, paragraphs 5 and 6 are added after paragraph 4 and read:
» For violation of the provisions of this Act and subordinate regulations passed on the basis of this Act, the sanitary inspector shall fine, on the spot on which a misdemeanour was

committed, the responsible person of the legal and natural person who performs the registered activity of production, placing on the market or use of biocidal products in the amount of HRK 1,000.

If the person fined for the misdemeanour referred to in paragraph 5 of this Article repeats the same misdemeanour he shall be fined on the spot on which the misdemeanour was committed in the amount of HRK 3,000.«

Article 6

The Minister shall adopt the Ordinance referred to in Article 3 of this Act within three months from the entry into force of this Act.

Article 7

This Act shall enter into force on the eighth day after the day of its publication in the Official Gazette, with the exception of Article 2 of this Act which shall enter into force on 21 March 2010.
