STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 23 of 2001

REGULATIONS

MADE by the Minister under section 38 of the Fisheries Act (Chap. 61:60).

(Gazetted 2nd August, 2001.)

1. These Regulations may be cited as the -

Short title.

FISHERIES (BERTHING) REGULATIONS, 2001.

2. A person shall not haul up or berth a fishing vessel in any area except in a designated landing area or site set out in Schedule I.

No berthing except in designated area.

Schedule I.

3. (1) A person shall not place, construct or erect any structure in a designated landing area except with the written permission of the Chief Fisheries Officer.

Permission to construct or erect structure.

- (2) any activity undertaken pursuant to subregulation (1) shall be undertaken in accordance with any conditions as may be set by the Chief Fisheries Officer from time to time.
- **4.** A person shall not carry out any activity or erect any structure in a designated landing area which will in any way impede the activities of fishermen, except with the written authorization of the Chief Fisheries Officer.

Erection of structure etc. that impede activities of fishermen.

5. (1) Any person who uses or occupies any public structure or facility erected at a designated landing area shall pay the fee specified in Schedule II to the assigned management authority.

Fees payable for use of facilities.

Schedule II.

FISHERIES (BERTHING) REGULATIONS

- (2) The fees payable pursuant to subregulation (1) shall be paid to the Chief Fisheries Officer on or before the tenth day of each month and shall be applied for the maintenance of such facility.
- (3) In this regulation, "public structure or facility" includes locker rooms, net lofts, meeting rooms, bathrooms and storage facilities.

Damage etc. to facilities.

6. A person who -

- (a) engages in any act which causes or threatens damage to;
- (b) uses for any purpose other than that stipulated; or
- (c) engages in any action which impedes the appropriate use of,

any public structure or facility at a designated landing area commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars and imprisonment for six months.

Refusal to pay fees.

- **7.** A person who refuses to pay for use, or occupancy of any public structure or facility at a designated landing area commits an offence and -
- (a) is subject to a written notice from the Chief Fisheries Officer to vacate the facility within a period of time therein stated; and
- (b) is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three hundred dollars and imprisonment for three months.
