MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 28 OF THE PLANT PROTECTION AND QUARANTINE ACT, CHAPTER 58:40.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the -

Short title.

PLANT PROTECTION (IMPORTATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2003.

2. In these Regulations "the Principal Regulations" means the Plant Protection (Importation) Regulations.

Interpretation. Ch. 58:40 Sub. leg.

3. Regulation 13 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended -

Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

- (a) by renumbering that regulation as subregulation (1); and
- (b) by inserting the following as subregulation (2) of that regulation
 - "(2) The permit issued for the importation of planting materials into the State under regulation 12 and the importation of fruits and vegetables into the State under this regulation shall be substantially in the form set out in the Schedule as Form 1A"

4. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the following Form 1 A immediately after Form 1.
