VANILLA REGULATIONS

deemed to be made under section 55

Commencement.

[13th February 1926]

Short title.

1. These Rules may be cited as the –

VANILLA REGULATIONS.

Branding of
green vanilla.

2. Until further order the branding of green vanilla shall be optional, provided that if any grower elects to register a mark he shall not thereafter be entitled to sell vanilla branded with a different mark.

Registration of
brands.

3. If a grower wishes to register a brand he may do so by sending a copy of the design of the brand to the Commissioner of Police with a written request for the registration of the same. The grower shall at the same time supply the Commissioner of Police with a sufficient number of copies of the design for distribution to the customs at Roseau and Portsmouth and to all the police stations in the State and the Commissioner of Police shall distribute the copies accordingly, and each copy of the design shall be available for reference at all reasonable and proper times when required.

Imitation of
brands forbidden.

4. No second or other brand shall be registered which shall appear to the Commissioner of Police to be the same as, or a colorable imitation of, any brand already registered.
