Animal reproductive material labeling requirements

Adopted on 17.11.2021 No. 55

The Regulation is established on the basis of Section 41 (7) of the Veterinary Act.

§ 1. Scope of regulation

The regulation lays down the veterinary labeling requirements for semen, ova and embryos collected from cattle, pigs, sheep, goats and equines for the purpose of marketing and stored for the said purpose.

§ 2. Labeling of animal reproductive material packaging

The packaging of sperm, ova and embryos collected for the purpose of marketing from an agricultural animal belonging to the animal species specified in paragraph 1 shall state the following information about this reproductive material:

- 1) the date and year of collection of the reproductive material;
- 2) the name and registration number of the agricultural animal in the register of agricultural animals;
- 3) breed of farm animal;
- 4) license number of the company that organized the collection of reproduction material and the two-letter code EE representing Estonia.

§ 3. Entry into force of the regulation

The regulation enters into force on December 1, 2021.
