List of the animal species to which a person prepares a biosecurity plan when keeping animals

Adopted on 17.11.2021 No. 56

The Regulation is established on the basis of Section 36 (2) of the Veterinary Act .

§ 1. Scope of regulation

The regulation establishes a list of the animal species to which an entrepreneur must draw up a biosecurity plan when keeping animals.

§ 2. Preparation of a biosecurity plan

The entrepreneur prepares a biosecurity plan for keeping animals belonging to the following animal species:

- 1) pigs;
- 2) fish and crustaceans, if they are kept in an aquaculture enterprise;
- 3) poultry, if there are more than 50 of them in the company.

§ 3. Entry into force of the regulation

- (1) The regulation enters into force on December 1, 2021.
- (2) Point 3 of Section 2 enters into force on December 1, 2022.
