The list of animal diseases that are mandatorily controllable and need-based controllable, for which disease damage is compensated

Adopted on 17.11.2021 No. 54

The Regulation is established on the basis of Section 65 (6) of the Veterinary Act .

§ 1. Scope of regulation

The regulation establishes a list of those animal diseases that are mandatorily controlled and need-based control, in which the damage caused by animal disease control is compensated.

§ 2. List of mandatorily controlled and need-based controlled animal diseases

Damage caused by animal disease control is compensated for the following mandatorily controllable and need-based controllable animal diseases:

- 1) bovine brucellosis;
- 2) bovine tuberculosis;
- 3) bovine enzootic leukosis;
- 4) sheep-goat brucellosis (B. melitensis);
- 5) rabies.

§ 3. Entry into force of the regulation

The regulation enters into force on December 1, 2021.
