WATER SUPPLY ACT
(CHAPTER 89—1955 EDITION)

WATER (LIMITATION) (RAKIRAKI) ORDER, 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by by-law 15 of the Water Supply By-Laws, 1955, I hereby prohibit the use of water from the Rakiraki Water Supply System for—

- (a) the washing of all vehicles, boats, ships, or vessels, buildings, structures, roads, streets and yards:
 Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to the use of water in the public interest, or for the maintenance of essential hygiene;
- (b) the watering of crops, flowers, plants, trees, shrubs, rootcrops, lawns, fields, gardens, food gardens, orchards and plantations; and
- (c) the filling of private swimming pools.

 The above Order makes it an offence to use water in certain ways punishable by a fine not exceeding \$20.
