**WATER SUPPLY ORDINANCE
(CHAPTER 89—1955 EDITION)**

WATER (LIMITATION) (SUVA) ORDER, 1986

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by by-law 15 of the Water Supply By-Laws, 1955, I hereby prohibit the use of water from the Suva Water Supply System including Suva, Lami, Nausori, Rewa Delta and surrounding areas for—

(a) washing of all vehicles, boats, ships, or vessels, buildings, structures, roads, streets and yards;

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to the use of water in the public interest, or for the maintenance of essential hygiene;

(b) the watering of crops, flowers, plants, trees, shrubs, rootcrops, lawns, fields, gardens, food gardens, orchards and plantations;

(c) the filling of private swimming pools.

Notice

(This Notice is not part of the above Order, but is published for general information.)

The above Order makes it an offence to use water in certain ways punishable by a fine not exceeding \$400 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Any premises which receives water through a piped and metered supply in or around Suva is likely to receive water from the Suva Water Supply System.
