CHAPTER 194

WILD ANIMALS, BIRDS AND FISH PRESERVATION ACT SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION

Wild Animals, Birds and Fish Preservation Regulations

being the Schedule to the Act as subsequently amended

As amended by Regulations 3 of 1929, 8 of 1933, 6 of 1937, 15 of 1936, 9 of 1948, 1 of 1961. L.N. 89 of 1963, 115 of 1963, 33 of 1966.

1. No person shall at any time—

Prohibitions.

- (1) wilfully kill, wound, or take any wild bird specified in Table I hereof;
- (2) take, remove, injure or destroy any nest of any such bird;
- (3) expose for sale, or knowingly have in his possession, any such bird, or any part of such bird, killed, or wounded or taken in The Gambia, or the nest, or egg, or plumage of any such bird taken in The Gambia;
- (4) export, or attempt to export, the skin of any such bird, killed, wounded or taken, or the nest, or egg, or plumage of any such bird taken in The Gambia.

Onus on person charged.

In any prosecution under this section the onus shall be upon the person charged to prove that the bird or part thereof, or the nest, egg, or plumage of such bird forming the subject matter of such charge was not killed, wounded, or taken in The Gambia.

Animals, etc. mentioned in Tables II and III. 2. No person shall at any time hunt, capture, or kill any animal or bird mentioned in Table II hereof, or the young of any animal mentioned in Table III, or the female of any animal in Table III when accompanied by its young.

Hippopotami. 3. No hippopotamus shall be hunted, captured, wounded or killed when in the River Gambia or its creeks or tributaries.

Animals, etc., mentioned in Table IV. 4. From the 16th June in any year until the 31st December next following (both days included), no person shall hunt, capture, or kill any animal mentioned in Table IV hereof.

Animals mentioned in Table V. 5. From the 1st July in any year until the 31st December next following (both days included), no person shall hunt, capture, or kill any bird mentioned in Table V hereof.

Close season for bush fowl.

6. No person shall hunt, capture or kill between the 1st September in any year and the last day of February following (both days included) the bird mentioned in Table VI.

Birds' eggs.

7. No person shall at any time take out of the nest, or destroy in the nest, the eggs of any bird mentioned in Tables I, II, V and VI hereof.

Licences.

8. No person shall at any time hunt, capture, or kill any animal mentioned in Table III hereof, the hunting, capture, or killing of which is not forbidden by these regulations, without having in force a licence of the kind numbered I in regulation 9 hereof; and no person shall at any time hunt, capture, or kill any animal mentioned in Table IV hereof without having in force one of the licences mentioned in regulation 9 hereof, and issued to him in accordance with these regulations.

9. A licence shall be in whichever of the forms hereinafter set Forms and forth shall be appropriate and the following fees shall be payable licences. therefor annually, viz-

10. (1) Licences of the kind numbered I and II in the last Duration preceding regulation shall be annual and shall cease to be in force of licences. on the 1st July next following the date of issue. Such licences may be issued by the Accountant-General or by any Commissioner and the fees therefor shall be paid into the general revenue of The Gambia.

(2) Licences of the kind numbered III in the last preceding regulation shall remain in force for twelve months from the date of issue. Such licences shall be issued in the City of Bathurst by the Accountant-General, the fees therefor to be paid into the general revenue of The Gambia, and in any other area of The Gambia by the Area Council having jurisdiction therein under the provisions of the Local Government Act, the fees therefor to be paid into the Cap. 109. revenue of such Area Council.

11. All licences shall be subject to the provisions of these regula- Condition tions and any other regulations for the time being in force.

12. It shall be in the discretion of the officer or the Executive Discretion Officer of the Area Council to whom application is made for a licence. licence to refuse to issue the same, subject to appeal to the Minister, whose decision shall be final.

13. If there be any question as to which licence should be granted Decision as to any person, the decision of the officer issuing the licence shall be licence. final.

Licence holders to render return. 14. Every holder of a general licence shall on or before the 31st July next following the issue of his licence render to the Accountant-General or to the Commissioner of the district in which the animals shall have been captured or killed, a return of all the animals mentioned in Table III hereof which he shall have captured or killed since the last day of the previous December.

Prevention of damage to crops, etc. 15. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in these regulations, any person who, having given satisfactory evidence of the necessity for so doing is authorised by the Commissioner so to do may hunt, capture or kill any animal or bird which is found causing damage to any crops, cattle, land or other property or whose presence in any district is considered likely to result in such damage.

Special emergency power to hunt marauding beasts.

(2) Nothing in these regulations shall prevent any person whose crops, cattle, lands or other property are in imminent danger of serious injury by any animals or birds hereinafter mentioned, or any person requested or authorised by him from hunting, capturing or killing such animals or birds in order to prevent such injury:

Provided that the burden of proving that such serious injury was imminent shall rest upon the person hunting, capturing or killing any such animal or bird or requesting or authorising another to do so.

(3) Any person killing any animal or bird under the provisions of this regulation shall not be required to be in possession of any licence under these regulations.

Vultures.

16. It shall be lawful, with the consent of the Minister first obtained, to hunt, capture and kill vultures within the limits of the City of Bathurst.

Use of bright lamps prohibited.

17. No person shall hunt any wild animals or birds by using a bright lamp or other portable light for the purpose of dazzling them or otherwise rendering them more easy prey.

18. Every person who shall be found having in his possession without lawful excuse (the proof of which shall lie on such person), a bright lamp or other portable light which, in the opinion of the made or court, is specially made or adapted for the purpose of hunting wild animals or birds as mentioned in regulation 17 shall be guilty of an prohibited. offence under these regulations.

Possession of

19. No person shall use any motor vehicle or vehicle or aircraft Prohibition for the purpose of hunting, capturing or killing any wild animals or birds.

aeroplanes and motor vehicles for hunting animals and birds.

20. No person for the purpose of hunting, capturing or killing Prohibition shall cause wild animals or birds to be encircled or surrounded by fires.

21. No person shall use any poison or explosive for the purpose of catching fish.

Prohibition of poison or for catching fish.

22. No person shall use any flare, poison or poisoned weapons for the purpose of hunting or capturing any animal.

Prohibition of flares and poison for hunting animals.

23. No person shall use any pit, enclosure, gin, trap, snare, set Prohibition gun or missile containing explosive for the purpose of hunting or traps. capturing any animal.

24. A list of the names of all holders of Nos. I and II licences List of licence issued in the preceding month shall be published monthly in the Gazette, and shall be exhibited by the Accountant-General at the Treasury.

25. Any person contravening the provisions of these regulations Penalty. shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty-five pounds for each offence or, in default of payment, to imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for a term not exceeding six months.
