STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 47 OF 2021

THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON HIM BY SECTION 78 (4) OF THE CUSTOMS ACT NO. 9 OF 2015, HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

(Gazetted 30th December, 2022).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the

CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE II) ORDER, 2022

and shall be read as one with the Customs Act No. 9 of 2015 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”.

2. Commencement. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 2022 and shall expire on the 1st day of April 2023.

3. Amendment of Schedule II to principal Act. Schedule II to the principal Act is amended in section 8 as follows—

- (a) by repealing subsection (1)(e)(i) and (ii) and substituting therefor the following new sub-paragraphs—

“(i) the cost of transport of the imported goods to the port or place of importation, as assessed in accordance with subsection (1A);

(ii) loading and handling charges associated with the transport of imported goods to the port or place of importation, as assessed in accordance with subsection (1A);”;

- (b) by inserting after sub-section (1) the following new subsection—

“(1A) The costs and charges under subsection (1)(e)(i) and (ii) shall be assessed by multiplying the actual costs and charges paid in respect of goods imported from a region specified in Column 1 by the percentage specified in Column 2 of the following table—

Column 1 Region	Column 2 Rate
North America	100%
South America	81%
CARICOM	50%
Africa	100%
Asia	36%
Europe	100%
Oceania	68%

”.
