STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 27 OF 2021

THE MINISTER OF TRADE, INDUSTRY, AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE GRENADA BUREAU OF STANDARDS, UNDER SECTION 18 (1) OF THE STANDARDS ACT CAP. 310 HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the

COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2021.

2. Amendment of Compulsory Standards Order, 1995. The Compulsory Standards Order, 1995, SRO No. 8 of 1995 is amended in section 2 by deleting items 1 and 2.

3. Declaration of compulsory standard. The following standards are declared compulsory standards—

- (a) GDS 1: Part 1: 2021 – Labelling of Goods – General Requirements (revision 1);
- (b) GDS 1: Part 2: 2021 – Labelling of Goods – Specific Requirements for Pre-packaged Goods (revision 1).

4. Purpose of standard. The purpose for which the standards are intended is as follows—

- (a) to protect the consumer or user against danger to health and safety;
- (b) to prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading advertising or labelling.

5. Commencement. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 2021.
