AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE IMPORTATION OF LIVE FISH.

[22nd September, 1951.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the

IMPORTATION OF FISH (REGULATION) ORDINANCE.

Permission of
Governor
necessary.

2. No person shall import any live fish into the Colony without the prior permission in writing of the Governor.

Importation
of certain
fish
absolutely
prohibited.

3. No permission under the foregoing section shall be given in respect of the importation of —

(a) black bass ;

(b) carp (all varieties) ; and

(c) goldfish (all varieties).

Penalty.

4. Any person who imports live fish contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred dollars, and any fish imported in contravention of this Ordinance shall be forfeited.
