1. This Ordinance may be cited as the

Short title.

OYSTER FISHERY ORDINANCE.

2. The Governor in Council may frame rules for the Governor in control and regulation of the oyster fishery in the Colony, Council to frame rules. and may impose penalties (provided the same shall in no case exceed forty-eight dollars) for any breach of or failure to observe such rules.

3. After the rules have been published in the Gazette Rules to be and one of the local newspapers, and have been submitted published. to the Legislative Council, they shall have the force and effect of law.
