Territorial Sea"

LAW No.44 OF 5 April 1948 CONCERNING THE SCIENTIFIC  
CONSERVATION OF THE CONTINENTAL SHELF FISHERIES, AS AMENDED  
(By Provisional Act No.37 of 19 March 1952 (Stjórnartíðindi,  
1952, A 2)

...

Article 1. The Ministry of Fisheries shall issue regulations  
establishing explicitly bounded conservation zones within the  
limits of the continental shelf of Iceland; wherein all fisheries  
shall be subject to Icelandic rules and control; Provided that  
the conservation measures now in effect shall in no way be  
reduced. The Ministry shall further issue the necessary  
regulations for the protection of the fishing grounds within  
the said zones. The Fiskifélag Islands (Fisheries Society) and  
the Atvinnudeild Háskóla Islands (University of Iceland, Industrial  
Research Laboratories) shall be consulted prior to the promulgation  
of the said regulations.

The regulations shall be revised in the light of scientific  
research.

Article 2. The regulations promulgated under article 1 of the  
present law shall be enforced only to the extent compatible with  
agreements with other countries to which Iceland is or may  
become a party.

Article 4. The Ministry of Fisheries shall, to the extent  
practicable, participate in international scientific research  
in the interest of fisheries conservation.
