

# CONTROL OVER PRODUCTIVE FEMALE RUMINANTS (Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 35/Permentan/OT.140/7/2011, Dated July 5, 2011)

BY GRACE OF GOD THE ALMIGHTY  
THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

Considering:

- a. that in the framework of fulfilling the need of parent stocks of ruminants and preventing productive female ruminants from reducing, it is necessary to control productive female ruminants released by communities;
- b. that having regards to letter a and in order to implement the provision of Article 18 paragraph (4) of Law Number 18 Year 2009 on Animal Husbandry and Veterinary, it is necessary to regulate control over productive female ruminant by a regulation of the Minister of Agriculture;

In view of:

2. Law Number 18 Year 2009 on Animal Husbandry and Veterinary (Statute Book of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2009 Number 84, Supplement to Statute Book of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5015);
3. Government Regulation Number 38 Year 2007 on Sharing of Public Administration Affairs between

the Government, Provincial Administration and re-gency/Municipal Administration (Statute Book of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2007 Number 82, Supplement to Statute Book of the Republic of Indonesia Number 473/);

4. Government Regulation Number 19 Year 2010 on Procedures for Executing Task and Authority as well as Financial Statute of Governor as Representative of the Government in Provincial Region (Statute Book of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2010 Number 25, Supplement to Statute Book of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5107);
5. Presidential Decree Number 84/P Year 2009 on the Establishment of the Second United Indonesia Cabinet;
6. Presidential Regulation Number 47 Year 2009 on the Establishment and Organization of State Ministries;
7. Presidential Regulation Number 24 Year 2010 on Status, Tasks and Functions of State Ministries as well as First Echelon Organizational Structure, Tasks and Functions of State Ministries;
8. Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 35/Permentan/OT.140/8/2006 on Guidance for Conservation and Utilization of Genetic Resources of Animals;
9. Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 36/Permentan/OT.140/8/2006 on National Seedling System;

10. Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 61/Permentan/OT.140/10/2010 on Organizational Structure and Working Arrangement of the Ministry of Agriculture;

DECIDES :

To stipulate:

THE REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE ON CONTROL OVER PRODUCTIVE FEMALE RUMINANTS

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISION

Article 1

Referred to in this ministerial regulation as:

1. Control over productive female ruminants shall mean a series of activities to manage the utilization of productive female ruminants through identification of reproduction status, selection, netting, and seedling.
2. Identification of reproduction status shall mean a series of diagnostic activities to sort out productive and unproductive female ruminants.
3. Selection shall be a series of activities to select productive female ruminants from population in accordance with the parent stock.
4. Netting shall be a series of activities to obtain productive female ruminants to be used as parent stock from the results of selection.
5. Seedling shall be a series of breeding activities to produce parent stock in accordance with the proper livestock seedling guidance.

6. Productive female ruminant shall be big ruminant giving birth for less than five times or having less than eight years old and small ruminant giving birth for less than five times or having less than four years old.

7. Technical Executive Unit hereinafter called UPT shall be an independent organizational unit executing operationally technical tasks and/or technical tasks supporting the main organization, in the central and regions.

8. Service shall be an institution of regional government in charge of livestock and veterinary affairs in a province and regency/city.

9. Slaughtering House hereinafter called RPH shall be a building or building complex with specified designs and requirements, which is used as the slaughtering location of livestock for public consumption.

Article 2

The ministerial regulation shall be intended to become a basis for controlling productive female ruminants with a view of preserving the availability of parent stocks.

Article 3

The scope ruled in this ministerial regulation shall cover identification of reproduction status, selection, netting, seedling, financing, fostering and supervision, public participation and penal provision.

CHAPTER II

IDENTIFICATION OF REPRODUCTION STATUS

Article 4

- (1) Identification shall be executed to obtain productive female ruminants from the female ruminant population.
- (2) The identification as meant in paragraph (1) may be executed in technical executive unit, group of breeders, animal market, RPH or other points of service.

Article 5

- (1) The identification as meant in Article 4 shall be executed by veterinarians.
- (2) The veterinarians as meant in paragraph (1) shall be appointed by the Minister, governor or regent/mayor by virtue of their authority.

Article 6

The identification as meant in Article 4 paragraph (1) shall be executed in accordance with criteria:

- a. big ruminant giving birth for less than five times or having less than eight years old and small ruminant giving birth for less than five times or having less than four years and six months old;
- b. not invalid physically;
- c. having normal reproduction organ and/or not invalid permanently; and
- d. matching the veterinary requirements.

Article 7

- (1) The result of the identification as meant in Article 6 shall be obtained from unproductive and productive female ruminants.

- (2) The unproductive female ruminants as meant in paragraph (1) shall be fattened to become livestock.
- (3) The productive female ruminants as meant in paragraph (1) shall be selected for parent stock.

CHAPTER III  
SELECTION

Article 8

The selection of productive female ruminants as meant in Article 7 paragraph (3) shall be executed to obtain productive female ruminants in accordance with the criteria for parent stock.

Article 9

- (1) The selection as meant in Article 8 shall be executed by parent stock supervisor.
- (2) The parent stock supervisor as meant in paragraph (1) shall be appointed by the Minister, governor or regent/mayor by virtue of their authority.

Article 10

- (1) The selection as meant in Article 8 shall be done in accordance with the requirements:
  - a. genuine livestock and/or purely local;
  - b. healthy and free from infectious animal disease declared by certificate of veterinary; and
  - c. performance according to parent stock standard.
- (2) The requirement as meant in paragraph (1) letter c shall be based on species, age, quality and quantity according to proper livestock breeding guidance.

Article 11

The result of the selection as meant in Article 10 shall result in productive female ruminants in accordance with criteria for parent stock and productive female ruminants not matching the parent stock criteria.

Article 12

The productive female ruminants not matching the parent stock criteria as meant in Article 11 shall be cultivated in accordance with proper livestock breeding guidance.

Article 13

The productive female ruminants matching the parent stock criteria as meant in Article 11 shall be recommended to the Minister, governor or regent/mayor by virtue of their authority for netting.

CHAPTER IV

NETTING

Article 14

- (1) The netting as meant in Article 13 shall be done by examining:
  - a. livestock ownership document issued by head of village;
  - b. certificate from veterinarian; and
  - c. livestock performance.
- (2) The productive female ruminants resulting from the netting as meant in paragraph (1) shall be marked for the need of seedling in UPT/UPTD, and/or group of breeders.

Article 15

The seedling as meant in Article 14 paragraph (2) shall be done through nourishment as well as refer to proper livestock seedling guidance.

CHAPTER V

FINANCING

Article 16

- (1) The government, provincial governments and regency/municipal governments by virtue of their authority shall provide funds for controlling productive female ruminants.
- (2) The provision of funds by the government, provincial governments and regency/municipal governments as meant in paragraph (1) may be done on the basis of priority of livestock to be netted in accordance with specific location.

CHAPTER VI

FOSTERING AND SUPERVISION

Article 17

- (1) The Minister, governor and/or regent/mayor by virtue of their authority shall foster the control over productive female ruminants.
- (2) The fostering as meant in paragraph (1) shall be done through socialization and enhancement of public participation.

Article 18

- (1) Control over productive female ruminants may be supervised directly or indirectly.
- (2) The direct supervision as meant in paragraph (1) shall be done in a coordinative manner by the

Minister along with governor and regent/mayor for the execution of control over productive female ruminants.

- (3) The indirect supervision as meant in paragraph (1) shall be done through reporting.
- (4) The reporting as meant in paragraph (3) shall be done every month.

Article 19

- (1) The reporting of identification of reproduction status, selection and netting in regency/city shall be submitted by head of regency/municipal service to regent/mayor periodically every month with a copy made available to the head of provincial service.
- (2) The reporting of identification of reproduction status, selection and netting in province shall be submitted by head of provincial service to governor periodically every month with a copy made available to the Minister in this case the Director General of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary.
- (3) The reporting of identification of reproduction status, selection and netting by UPT shall be submitted to the Director General of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary.

CHAPTER VII

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Article 20

- (1) The public participation as meant in Article 17 paragraph (2) may be done as from the identification of reproduction status, selection, netting and/or seedling.

- (2) The operational cost of the activity as meant in paragraph (1) shall be charged to the said communities.

CHAPTER VIII

PENAL PROVISION

Article 21

- (1) Productive female ruminants may not been slaughtered except for the need of research, nourishment and/or control and mitigation of animal diseases.
- (2) Any violation of the slaughtering of the productive female ruminants as meant in paragraph (1) shall be subject to administrative sanction or penalty in accordance with Law Number 18 Year 2009 on Animal Husbandry and Veterinary.

CHAPTER IX

CONCLUSION

Article 22

Control over productive female ruminants shall be executed in location and time stipulated by the Minister, governor and/or regent/mayor by virtue of authority.

Article 23

The ministerial regulation shall come into force as from the date of promulgation.

For public cognizance, the regulation shall be promulgated by placing in State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
