

LABELING OF WARNING IN FOOD SUPPLEMENT CONTAINING VITAMIN K
 (Circular of the Deputy for Supervision over Traditional Medicines,
 Cosmetics and Complementary Product No. PO.01.04.4.41.053 dated March 16,2007)

To:
 Executives of Pharmaceutical Companies/Industries
 Throughout Indonesia

In a bid to protect public health from risks arising from the use of products not fulfilling the security requirements, the following information is provided:

1. Companies having food supplement containing Vitamin K must improve label by mentioning warning: Do Not Give to People in the Course of Treatment by Warfarin or the similar medicine".
2. The revised label should be given up to the Food and Drug Supervisory Board in this case the Directorate of Traditional Medicine, Food Supplement and Cosmetic Evaluation.
3. Food supplement containing Vitamin K with the old label and produced before the issuance of this circular can be distributed and must adjust to the provi-

sion in this circular in a transitional period of 6 (six) months as from the date of issuance of this circular.

4. In the case of the provision being not yet fulfilled after the deadline elapses, the relevant shall be subject to sanction in the form of withdrawal of products and nullification of approval number of registration.
