Diseases of Animals Act, 1966 (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Restriction on Movement of Persons) (Amendment) Order, 2001

I, Joe Walsh, Minister for Agriculture and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 3 and 15 of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1966 (No.6 of 1966) (as amended by the Diseases of Animals (Amendment) Act, 2001 (No. 3 of 2001) and adapted by the Agriculture and Food (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order, 1999 (S.I. No. 307 of 1999)), hereby order as follows -

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Animals Act, 1966 (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Restriction on Movement of Persons) (Amendment) Order, 2001.
2. The Diseases of Animals Act, 1966 (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Restriction on Movement of Persons) Order, 2001 (S.I. No. 160 of 2001) is amended -
 - (a) in Article 3, the substitution for “The United Kingdom” of “Great Britain”,
 - (b) in Article 4 and Article 5(1), the substitution for “the United Kingdom” of “Great Britain” in each place where it Occurs, and
 - (c) the deletion of Article 4(4).
