European Communities (Marketing of Vegetable Propagating and Planting Material, Other than Seed) (Amendment) Regulations 2005

I, Mary Coughlan, Minister for Agriculture and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) and for the purpose of giving effect to Commission Decision 2005/55/EC of 25 January 2005, hereby make the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Marketing of Vegetable Propagating and Planting Material, Other than Seed) (Amendment) Regulations 2005.
- 2. The European Communities (Marketing of Vegetable Propagating and Planting Material, Other than Seed) (S.I. No. 159 of 1994) are amended in Regulation (2) 1 by substituting the following for the definition of "The Directive" -

"' The Directive' means Council Directive No. 92/33/EEC of 28 April 1992; Commission Directive 93/61/EEC of 2 July 1993; Commission Directive 93/62/EEC of 5 July 1993 and Commission Decision 2005/55/EC of 25 January 2005;"
