The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Sections 8(2) and 25 of the Wildlife Act, 1976 (No. 39 of 1976), and the Heritage (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order, 2002 (S.I. No. 356 of 2002) hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Wildlife (Wild Mammals) (Open Seasons) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2008.

2. In this order the “Principal Order” means the Wildlife (Wild Mammals) (Open Seasons) Order, 2005 (S.I. No. 550 of 2005) as amended by the Wildlife (Wild Mammals) (Open Seasons) (Amendment) Order, 2008 (S.I. No. 27 of 2008).

3. The Schedule to the “Principal Order” is amended by substituting for the final entry relating to the Muntjac deer the following:—
