Resolution No. (11)

Date : 10-Shawal- 1417 H.

17 - 2 - 1997 A.D.

In accordance of with the provisions of Para. (A) of Article (42) of the Constitution, the Revolutionary Command Council have decided the following :-

Firstly :- The governors shall be authorized the the power of confiscating the sheeps wanted for trafficking outside Iraq, and thier decisions in this respect shall be final.

Secondly : The suspicious charged with a crime of trafficking sheeps outside Iraq, shall be applied by the provisions of the customs Law No. (23) of 1988 and the other valid legislations.

Thirdly : The reporters and the persons who exposed the sheeps wanted to be trafficking and the assistant systems to complete the measures of siezure and confiscation the sheeps shall be granted the rewards stipulated in the Revolutionary Command Council Resolution No. (111) of 1996.

Fourthly : -1 - The courts shall be prevented form hearing the lawsuits resulted from the application of the provisions of this Resolution.

2- The judgements and decisions issued before coming into force of this Resolution which are not aequired the final stage including the amendment or abrogation of the decisions of the governors of confiscating the sheeps shall be cancelled in accordance with the provisions of the Revolutionary Command Council Resolution No. (436) of 1985.

Fifthly : The Minister of Finance shall issue instructions necessary to facilitate the imple-mentaion of this Resolution.

Sixthly : This Resolution shall be implemented

In accordance with the provisions of Para. (B) of Article 62 of the Constitution and Para. (3) of Article (7) of passport law No. (55) of 1959, the following Regulation has been promulgated.

Regulation No. 1 of 1997

Amendment To The Regulation Of Passports

No. 61 Of 1959

Article - 1 -

Article -2- of Passport Regulation No.(61) of 1959, shall be repealed and substituted by the following :

(Article -2-)

The Passport shall be consisted of 60 Pages and there is another passport justas redif of 48 pages, except the cover, the width of the page shall be (10) cm and the cover of ordinary passport shall be dark green colour and coarse to the touch and the pages having pair numbers shall be in the right side of the passport and shall have two colours which are green and light violet, as for the pages having singular numbers being in the left side of the passport shall be in two colours orange and light violet and the cover of the diplomatic passport and diplomatic one of holder of political mail and Service shall be dark red.

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red.

In the middle of the passport in its all kinds there shall be the Emblem of the Republic of Iraq and shall be surrounded from the top by the Victory Arch and shall be joined between them the Iraq Map and in the middle of every page there shall be the octangular star in a size of 8,5 cm² and in side of it there shall be the Victory Arch and the number of the page shall be written in Arabic language, and on the top of the star from the middle the Emblem of the Republic of Iraq and in the upper right side and the down left side there shall be the drawing of the Babylon palm the date of its publication in the Official Gazette. side shall be an octagon star with the size of 2,8 cm and inside of it there shall be the victory Arch and the number of the page in English language.

Article -2 -

This Regulation shall be implemented from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
