The Revolutionary Command Council
Resolution No. (64)**

**Dated : 2nd. Muharram, 1415 H.,
11-6-1994. A.D.**

In accordance with the provisions of Para. (A) of Article (42) of the Constitution.

The Revolutionary Command Council have decided the following:-

Law No. (9) Of 1994

Aba'a Centre For Agricultural Researches

Article - 1 -

There shall be established in accordance with this Law a centre in the name of (Aba'a Centre For the Agricultural Researches to be connected with the Council of Ministers and Baghdad shall be its headquarters.

Article - 2 -

The Centre shall enjoy with juristic personality and with the financial and administrative independence.

Article 3

The Centre shall aim at :

- 1- To raise the standard of scientific and agricultural commander of disbursement therein, and well as working for transporting the modern results of researches and techniques into the actual field, and following up and analysing its results.
- 2- Extracting and entering the plant and animal strains and the augmentation of their origins.
- 3- Increasing the seeds and the approved and recorded seeds (Toqawi) and their distribution on the beneficiaries.
- 4- Implementing any of the developing projects of temporary nature.

Article 4

The center shall be headed by an official of a special grade holding the Doctorate in one of the agricultural specializations, and shall be the commander of disbursement therein, and shall be assisted by two directors general or more.

Article 5

- 1- The center shall be consisted of the following two departments, and each one of them shall be managed by an official in a grade of director general.
 - A- The department of researches and studies.
 - B- The department of developing the production and techniques transformation.
- 2- The tasks and formations of the two departments above shall be defined by an Instructions issued by head of the Centre.
- 3- It is permissible to create any other department in the centre by the assent of council of Ministers.

Article 6

The head of the centre shall practise the following competences and specializations:

- 1- Approving the scientific research plan and developing the production of the center.
- 2- Approving the programs of transforming the new techniques to the applying field and following up their implementation and adaptation.
- 3- Defining the utilization fields and the coordination among the scientific and agricultural establishments in the Country and their similar in the Arab Homeland
- 4- Approving the formula of the contracts being concluded with the farmers and the local, Arab, and foreign companies.
- 5- Approving the estimative budget project of the centre and its final accounts.
- 6- Approving the opening of the branches for the centre in the governorates of the Country and establishing stations of the researches and developing the production.
- 7- Approving the Center's cadre and the consent to appoint the researchers and officials in the centre and concluding contracts with those of which the centre needs on their services from Iraqis, Arabs and foreigners and their scholarships.
- 8- The consent on the scientific devotion and the study leaves for the staff of the Centre.

- 9- Writing off, of what has been missed or damaged of materials and instruments which the competent authorities deem of their written off.
 - 10- The announcement of the works and their referring and commencing with the implementation (public tender or direct invitation) to the limit of a Million Dinar.
 - 11- The formation of Permanent and interim committees.
 - 12- The disbursement with the limits of (25) twenty five thousand dinars for one case to avoid the hospitality expenditures.
 - 13- Imposing the punishments on the centre's staff of those who are in the second grade and below.
 - 14 Evaluation of the performance of leading cadres, researchers and the officials.
 - 15- Granting the financial rewards in limit of (25) twenty - five thousands Dinars to every case according to the instructions.
 - 16- Deciding the distribution of the samples or origins for the researching or applying purposes.
 - 17- Issuing orders, concerning with the organization of the administrative affairs of the centre's staff.
 - 18- Operating the officials in the overtime duties after the official working hours according to the law.
 - 19- Disbursing on the transporting techniques requirements into the applying field of the planters and compensating whoever, being harmed according to the contracts concluded with them.
 - 20- Seeking assistance with any one of the state officials and socialist sector, for the purposes of the centre.
 - 21- Whatever is being entrusted to him of duties and other tasks.

Article 7

The head of the centre shall be entitled any of his powers and jurisdictions stipulated in Article -6- of this Law to the Directors General of the Sections Heads in the Centre.

Article 8

The financial resources of the centre shall be consisted of the following:

- 1- The annual grant specified thereto.
- 2- The revenues of its products, the service wages, the consultations, researches, the rights of property, patent, publications and other activities of the centre.
- 3- Gifts, aids, and donations.

Article 9

The cadre of the centre shall be continued for submission to the provisions of services, disciplinary and pension applied thereon, before coming into force of this Law.

Article 10

- 1- The importations of the centre shall be exempted from the importation licence and the provisions connected with foreign exchange stipulated in the law of Central Bank of Iraq, shall be exempted from custom's imports duties and the custom surtages.
- 2- The tasks and accounts of the centre shall be excluded from the provisions of General Account Rules Law and the Law of Diwan of Financial Control.

Article - 11 -

The head of the Centre may issue instructions to facilitate the execution of this Law.

Article - 12 -

This Law shall be published in the Official Gazette.
