The Revolutionary Command Council
Resolution No. (193)

Date : 4th. Jumadi Al- Akhira 1415 H.
7th. November, 1994 A.D.

In accordance with the provisions of Para.
(A) of Article (42) of the Constitution.

The Revolutionary Command Council have
decided to promulgate the following Law:

No. (24) of 1994

Law of the Planning Body

Article - 1 -

A Body in the name of (Planning Body)
shall be founded and connected with Council of
Ministers and it shall exercise the following
tasks:-

Firstly - Proposing the overall and sectoral econ-
omical and social policies connected with
the national development operation.

Secondly - Putting down the general objectives
and the overall and sectoral development
indicators for the National Development
Plans.

Thirdly - Preparing the National Development
plans with the co-operation and coordination
with the ministries and authorities not con-
nected with a ministry.

Fourthly - The central following up to implement
the National Development plans and the pro-
duction plans and evaluating their results.

Fifthly - Evaluating the process of the economi-
cal development of its overall and sectorial
dimensions in a periodical phase and sub-
mitting the results to the supreme author-
ities.

Sixthly - Evaluating the results of studies of the
technical and economical advantage for the
projects and programmes of the integrated
development prior of entering them in the
National Development Plans.

Sevently - Preparing researches and studies
connected with the planning and develop-
ment operation in Iraq.

Eighthly - Giving opinion in the legislations

having directly relation with the economical
development operation before legislating
same.

Ninthly - Laying down strategies of the regional
development and the bases and policies re-
lating with the urban, rural development
within the frame of the National Develop-
ment Plans.

Tenthly - To decide on whatever is connected
with the planning and coordination matters
concerning the projects and the integrated
developing programmes for the develop-
ment plans within the limits of the compe-
tencies granted to the Body.

Article - 2 -

The Body shall be administered by a director
in a special grade to be connected with the Secre-
tariat of Council of Ministers.

Article - 3-

The Body shall be consisted of the following
formations:-

Firstly - The Central Organization for Statistics.

Secondly - Agricultural Planning Department.

Thirdly - Industrial Planning Department.

Fourthly - Planning Department of Transporta-
tion and Communications.

Fifthly - Planning Department for the Manpower.

Sixthly - Planning Department of the Construc-
tion, Housing and Services.

Sevently - Department of the Economic Plann-
ing.

Eleventhly - Director of the Body's Bureau.

Ninthly - The Legal Department.

Tenthly - The Administrative and Financial De-
partment.

Eleventhly - Director of the Body's Bureau.

Twelfthly - Auditing Division.

Article - 4 -

Firstly - The Central Organization for Statistics
shall exercise the tasks and jurisdictions pro-
vided for in the Law of Statistics No. (21)
of 1972 and the Regulation of the Central
Organization for Statistics No. (1) of 1987,

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and the Instructions issued accordingly.

Secondly - The Central Organization For Statistics shall be managed by a director in a special grade holding the First university certificate at least from those having the experience and qualification.

Article - 5 -

Firstly - Departments of the Body and the Director of the Body's Bureau, as well as the Audit Division shall exercise the tasks and jurisdictions provided for in the Instructions of defining tasks and jurisdictions of the Bodies and Departments of Ministry of Planning No. (1) of 1990, until the issuance of whatever shall replace thereof.

Secondly - Every Department of the departments stipulated in Article (3) of this Law shall be managed by a director general holding First university certificate at least from those having the experience and specialization .

Article - 6 - Firstly - 1 - The Ministry of Planning shall be repealed, and its officials shall be transferred to the Body founded by this Law except officials of the Central Organization for Standardization and Quality Control, as well as the National Centre of Electronic Computers: and the National Centre For Planning and Administrative Development.

2- The Law of Ministry of Planning No. (45) of 1985 shall be repealed.

3- The Revolution Command Council Resolution No. (455) of 2-6-1987 shall be abrogated.

Secondly - The Body founded by virtue of this Law shall replace the Ministry of Planning (as repealed) with all its rights and obligations.

Thirdly - The application of rules of service operated by the Ministry of Planning as repealed shall be continued on the officials of the Body and they shall receive the allowances of which the officials are receiving in the secretariat of Council of Ministers.

Article - 7 -

The Secretariat of Council of Ministers may issue instructions to facilitate the execution of the provisions of this Law.

Article - 8 -

This Law shall be implemented from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
