

RESOLUTIONS

INSTRUCTIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Para. (18) of the Law of Protecting and Improving the Environment No. (76) of 1986.

The Council of Protecting and Improving the Environment have decided to issue the following Instructions :-

Instructions No. (1) of 1992

The transmitting and supplying of potable water in basin tankers.

Article 1

It is not permissible the granting of the sanitary licence for transmitting and supplying the potable water unless after the ascertainment of the following:-

Firstly : The confirmation of the driver soundness from the contagious diseases.

Secondly : A consent from the responsible authority about the purity of potable water (Baghdad Amanate and Municipalities in the Governorates) to supply him with the required quantities of water periodically.

Thirdly : The driver should be pledged with writing before the committee mentioned thereto in Article (2) of this Instructions by his abiding in filling the car with the potable water from the places defined thereto from the competent authority responsible for purifying the water and he must transmit that water only.

Fourthly : The basin capacity of the tanker shall not be less than 5 cubic meter of the water

Fifthly : The basin of the tanker should be made of non-rusty metal or from plastic or other plastics allowed thereto.

Sixthly : To write on the outside face and on the two sides of the basin of the tanker and in an obvious and clear line and in a capital letters the phrase of (Potable Water).

Article 2

The licence mentioned thereto in Article (1) of this Instructions shall be granted from a committee consisted in each governorate by a resolution from the Council of Protecting and Improving the Environment and on the following aspect.

Firstly : A representative of the Council of Protecting and Improving the Environment in the governorate, his position shall not be less than a director As Chairman

Secondly : A representative of the Directorate of water and sewerages of the Governorate. As member.

Thirdly : A representative of the Directorate of Traffic of the Governorate As member.

Article 3

The driver of the basin car shall be bound to submit to the cadres of inspection whatever confirmed his supplying potable water from the competent authority in each time supplied with thereof and that shall contain the time and the date of supplying and the name of the accumulator or the project which supplied him with water.

Article 4

Firstly : It is not permissible for the stations of purifying to supply these tankers with water unless after the termination of the purifying and sterelyting operation and the confirming of the goodness of these water to the human consumption.

Secondly : The waters received in Item (Firstly) of this Article shall be allocated during a period of time not exceedings 3 hours in summer or six hours in winter to secure the continuity of their goodness to the human consumption.

Article 5

The Departments of Health in the governorates shall undertake the following :-

- 1- The periodical inspection over the cars to be sure of the soundness of their usage in pursuance of these Instructions.
- 2- The observing over the quality of the supplied water.

Article 6

The licence granted by virtue of these Instructions shall be renewed annually as from the date of its issuance and after the inspection by the committee mentioned thereto in Article

(2) to be ascertained of the availability of the conditions required by these Instructions.

Article 7

The contravenor of the provisions of these Instructions shall be punished by the punishments stipulated in the Law of Protecting and Improving the Environment No. (76) of 1986.

Article 8

These Instructions shall be executed from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

INSTRUCTIONS No. (2) OF 1992

Amendment to the Instructions of the Special Committee formed by the Revolutionary Command Council Resolution No. (643) of 1973 to manage endowed properties of the Mosaic Community

- 1- Para. (3) of Article (21) of the Special Committee Instructions No. (1) of 1974 formed by the Revolutionary Command Council Resolution No. (643) of 1973, to manage endowed properties of the Mosaic Community, shall be abrogated and the following substituted:-

"3- The expenditures of mangement of the endowment included the allowances of the members of the Special Committee shall be disbursed and total mentioned expenditures shall not exceed 20% of the annual revenues of the endowment and shall not exceed the sums of the annual allowances to any one of the members of the Special Committee (1800) one thousand and eight hundered Dinars annually."

- 2- These Instructions shall be implemented as from 1-1-1992.
