

## ANIMAL DISEASES REGULATIONS (VETERINARY CERTIFICATE), 1975<sup>12</sup>

By the authority vested in me by Section 20 of the *Animal Diseases Ordinance* 1945, I hereby stipulate the following Regulations:

### 1. Issue of Veterinary Certificate:

A State Veterinary Officer is empowered to issue a certificate regarding vaccinations, tests, identification marks, inspections and handling of animal as stated in the Regulations stipulated according to the Ordinance (hence - Veterinary Certificate).

### 2. Fees:

A fee will be paid for the Veterinarian Certificate, at the rate stated beside each animal as listed in the Schedule<sup>3</sup>.

### 3. Exemption:

A diplomatic representative or consular representative of a foreign country as defined in Paragraph 3 to the Addendum of the *Law of Customs, Excise and Purchase Tax (Cancellation of Special Exemptions)* and who is recognised by the Foreign Minister will be exempt from paying the fee.

### 4. Cancellations:

The *Animal Diseases Regulations (Veterinary Certificate)*, 1959 are hereby cancelled.

### 5. Effectivity:

These regulations become effective on the tenth day after their publication.

### 6. Name:

These Regulations shall be called "*Animal Disease Regulations (Veterinary Certificate)*, 1975".
