

VETERINARIANS REGULATIONS (QUALIFICATIONS FOR PRACTICE OF
VETERINARY MEDICINE BY PERSON WHO IS NOT A VETERINARIAN -
VACCINATION OF POULTRY), 5754-1994

By virtue of the power vested in me under S 4(a) Veterinarians Law 5751-1991 {1} and with the approval of the Economic Committee of the Knesset I hereby enact these Regulations:

Definitions 1. In these Regulations -

"Licence" - licence from the Director to carry out vaccination of poultry.

"Vaccination of poultry" - carrying out vaccination of poultry by any method of vaccination, including by injection, in drinking water, and by spray.

Licence to 2. A person, not being a veterinarian, may carry out vaccination of poultry if he
carry out has received a licence from the Director, subject to the provisions of these
Vaccination Regulations.

Application 3. A person applying for a licence shall lodge an application therefor with the
licence Director in the form set out in the Schedule hereto and shall annex to it the
confirmations and documents therein specified.

Qualifications for granting of licence	4. The Director shall not grant a licence to an applicant unless he possesses the following qualifications: (1) He has had a secondary education. (2) He has completed a course in the carrying out of vaccination of poultry recognised by the Director. (3) He has successfully passed an examination determined, or approved, by the Director.
Supervision by veterinarian	5. No poultry vaccinator shall carry out vaccination of poultry except under the supervision, and in the presence, of a veterinarian.
Commencement	6. These Regulations shall enter into force sixty days after their publication.
Transitional Provisions	7. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Regulation 4, the Director may grant a temporary licence for vaccination of poultry for a period of one year to any person who has applied for the same on the form set out in the Schedule hereto, if he is satisfied that by the time of the commencement of these Regulations the applicant will have been carrying out vaccination of poultry for at least three consecutive years. (b) A person granted a temporary licence may apply to the Director for the grant of a licence for vaccination of poultry and the Director shall grant him such a permit if he passes the examination stipulated in Regulation 4(3).
