AN ACT to Amend the Mortgage Insurance Act.

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----

1. This Act may be cited as the Mortgage Insurance (Amendment) short title Act, 2014, and shall be read and construed as one with the Mortgage and Insurance Act (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") and all amendments thereto.

- 2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended
 - in subsection (1)(b)(i) by deleting the words and numerals of principal (a) "90 per centum" and substituting therefor the words and numerals "97 per cent"; and

- (b) by deleting subsection (4) and substituting therefor the following-
 - " (4) The Minister may from time to time-
 - (a) vary the percentage of appraised value under subsection (1)(b)(i), by order subject to affirmative resolution; and
 - (b) prescribe variations in respect of the percentages or the amount specified in subsection (1)(b)(ii) or in section 5.".

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by deleting from Amendment of section 5 subsection (1) the words "per centum" and substituting therefor the of principal words "per cent".

4. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by deleting from subsection (2)(a) the words "per centum" and substituting therefor the words "per cent".
