THE AGRICULTURAL SMALL HOLDINGS REGULATIONS, 1946

(*Made by the Governor in Executive Council on the 4th day of March,
1946*)

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Small Holdings Regulations, 1946.

2. For the purposes of the Act, any tree of the class of trees specified in Part I of the First Schedule shall be an economic tree.

First Schedule.

3. For the purposes of the Act, any tree of the class of trees specified in Part II of the First Schedule shall be a prescribed tree.

4. For the purposes of section 8 of the Act, the areas specified in the Second Schedule shall be the areas in respect of which a landlord may, at the time when he enters into a rice tenancy contract, by the inclusion in such contract of an express term to that effect reserve to himself the exclusive right to graze cattle upon the holding for the period between the reaping of one crop of rice and the preparation of the land for planting the next crop.

5. The fees payable by a person desirous of being supplied with a copy of a registered contract of tenancy and of all documents filed therewith and endorsements thereon duly certified under the hand of the Registrar shall be those set out in the Third Schedule.
