## **BEE DISEASES CONTROL (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2010**

*Made**3rd June 2010**Coming into force**3rd June 2010*

**THE MINISTER FOR PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT**, in pursuance of Articles 28 and 42 of the Diseases of Animals (Jersey) Law 1956<sup>1</sup>, orders as follows –

### **1 Interpretation**

In this Order “principal Order” means the Bee Diseases Control (Jersey) Order 1992<sup>2</sup>.

### **2 Article 5 amended**

In Article 5 of the principal Order –

(a) for paragraph (1) there shall be substituted the following paragraph –

“(1) If the report on the examination of a sample submitted under Article 2(2) or Article 3(1)(a) confirms the presence of American foul brood the Minister may –

- (a) serve on the owner or person in charge of the hive from which the sample was taken a notice under paragraph (3);
- (b) declare by notice published in accordance with Article 10(2) an area specified in the notice, in which the presence of American foul brood has been confirmed, to be an infected area.”;

(b) after paragraph (4) there shall be inserted the following paragraph –

“(4A) A notice under paragraph (1)(b) may provide that all or any of the provisions specified in the Schedule shall apply in the infected area or in such parts thereof as are specified in the notice; and such a notice may provide for the application of different provisions to different parts of the infected area as the Minister considers necessary to prevent the spread of American foul brood.”.

**3 Article 6 amended**

In Article 6 of the principal Order –

- (a) in paragraph (1), after sub-paragraph (b) there shall be added the following sub-paragraph –

“(c) declare by notice published in accordance with Article 10(2) an area specified in the notice, in which the presence of European foul brood has been confirmed, to be an infected area.”;

- (b) after paragraph (4) there shall be inserted the following paragraph –

“(4A) A notice under paragraph (1)(c) may provide that all or any of the provisions specified in the Schedule shall apply in the infected area or in such parts thereof as are specified in the notice; and such a notice may provide for the application of different provisions to different parts of the infected area as the Minister considers necessary to prevent the spread of European foul brood.”.

**4 Article 10 amended**

In Article 10(2) of the principal Order, for the words “Article 7” there shall be substituted the words “Article 5, 6 or 7”.

**5 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Bee Diseases Control (Amendment) (Jersey) Order 2010 and shall come into force forthwith.
