ANIMAL HEALTH (CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2017

Made

18th January 2017

Coming into force

1st February 2017

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 34(2) of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016¹, have made the following Regulations –

1 Amendment of Diseases of Animals (Rabies) (Importation of Mammals) (Jersey) Order 2011

In Article 3(6) of the Diseases of Animals (Rabies) (Importation of Mammals) (Jersey) Order 2011² for the words “without prejudice to the Rabies (Control) (Jersey) Order 1976” there shall be substituted the words “without limiting the powers in the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016³ or the Animal Health (Rabies) (Jersey) Order 2016⁴”.

2 Amendment of European Communities Legislation (Bluetongue) (Jersey) Regulations 2008

For Regulation 2 of the European Communities Legislation (Bluetongue) (Jersey) Regulations 2008⁵ there shall be substituted the following Regulation –

“2 Applicability of other legislation

- (1) These Regulations are ‘relevant legislation’ for the purposes of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016⁶ and do not limit and are not limited by the application of that Law.
- (2) These Regulations are in addition to and not in derogation of the 2006 Order.”.

3 EU Legislation (Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies) (Jersey) Regulations 2015

In Regulation 3 of the EU Legislation (Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies) (Jersey) Regulations 2015⁷ after paragraph (3) there shall be added the following paragraph –

- “(4) These Regulations are ‘relevant legislation’ for the purposes of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016⁸ and do not limit and are not limited by the application of that Law.”.

4 Amendment of EU Legislation (Veterinary and Zootechnical Checks – Trade with Member States) (Jersey) Regulations 2016

- (1) The EU Legislation (Veterinary and Zootechnical Checks – Trade with Member States) (Jersey) Regulations 2016⁹ are amended as follows.
- (2) In Regulation 1 for the definitions “inspector” and “official veterinarian” there shall be substituted respectively the following definitions –
 - “ ‘inspector’ means a person appointed as such under Article 6(1) of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016¹⁰ and includes the States Veterinary Officer appointed under Article 5 of that Law;
 - ‘official veterinarian’ means –
 - (a) the States Veterinary Officer appointed under Article 5 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016; and
 - (b) any inspector designated as a veterinary inspector under Article 6(2) of that Law;”.
- (3) In Regulation 12(1) the words “Notwithstanding Schedule 1 to the Diseases of Animals (Jersey) Law 1956¹¹, but” shall be deleted.
- (4) For Regulation 24 there shall be substituted the following Regulation –

“24 Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016

- (1) These Regulations are not to be construed as permitting the importation of live cattle, which is prohibited by Article 14 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016¹².
- (2) These Regulations do not derogate from any prohibition, imposed by Order made under Article 7 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 on the importation of Antilocapridae, Camelidae, Caprinae, Cervidae, Giraffidae, Suidae and Tragulidae without a licence granted by the Minister.”.

5 Amendment of EU Legislation (Veterinary Checks – Imports from Third Countries) (Jersey) Regulations 2016

- (1) The EU Legislation (Veterinary Checks – Imports from Third Countries) (Jersey) Regulations 2016¹³ are amended as follows.
- (2) In Regulation 1 for the definitions “inspector” and “official veterinarian” there shall be substituted respectively the following definitions –
 - “ ‘inspector’ means a person appointed as such under Article 6(1) of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016¹⁴ and includes the States Veterinary Officer appointed under Article 5 of that Law;
 - ‘official veterinarian’ means –

- (a) the States Veterinary Officer appointed under Article 5 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016; and”
 - (b) any inspector designated as a veterinary inspector under Article 6(2) of that Law;”.
- (3) In Regulation 6(1) the words “Notwithstanding Schedule 1 to the Diseases of Animals (Jersey) Law 1956¹⁵,” shall be deleted.
- (4) For Regulation 18 there shall be substituted the following Regulation –

“18 Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016

- (1) These Regulations are not to be construed as permitting the importation of live cattle, which is prohibited by Article 14 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016¹⁶.
- (2) These Regulations do not derogate from any prohibition, imposed by Order made under Article 7 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 on the importation of Antilocapridae, Camelidae, Caprinae, Cervidae, Giraffidae, Suidae and Tragulidae without a licence granted by the Minister.”

6 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Health (Consequential Amendments) (Jersey) Regulations 2017 and shall come into force on 1st February 2017.
