

ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS (BOVINE SEMEN) (AMENDMENT No. 2) (JERSEY) ORDER 2017

THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT, in pursuance of Articles 7 and 32 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016¹, orders as follows –

1 Amendments to Artificial Insemination of Domestic Animals (Bovine Semen) (Jersey) Order 2008

In the Artificial Insemination of Domestic Animals (Bovine Semen) (Jersey) Order 2008^2 –

- (a) in Article 33, for the words "is be used" there shall be substituted the words "is to be used";
- (b) in Article 38, in paragraph (b) the word "and" shall be deleted and after that paragraph there shall be inserted the following paragraph
 - "(ba) the importer or consignee of the semen has notified the Minister in writing at least 24 hours in advance, of the nature of the consignment, its anticipated date of arrival in Jersey and where it is intended to be delivered; and";
- (c) in Article 48 the words "for the purposes of Article 2(3) of the Artificial Insemination of Domestic Animals (Jersey) Law 1952³" and paragraph (l) are deleted.

2 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Artificial Insemination of Domestic Animals (Bovine Semen) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2017 and shall come into force on 1st February 2017.
