### **THE FORESTS (FISH HATCHERIES) RULES**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Forests (Fish Hatcheries) Rules.
2. The Minister may, by order published in the Gazette, regulate the use and occupation of any demarcated forest or forest area for the purpose of installing commercial fish hatcheries under such terms and conditions as the Minister thinks fit, and for such period as is specified in such order.
3. The Minister may grant licences for the installation of commercial fish hatcheries under such terms and conditions as he thinks fit.

Orders under rule 2 of the above Rules

### **THE FORESTS (FISH HATCHERIES) ORDER**

1. This Order may be cited as the Forests (Fish Hatcheries) Order.
2. For a period not exceeding twenty years from the 18th December, 1950, the use and occupation of the forest area described in the Schedule to this Order shall, for the purpose of installing commercial fish hatcheries, be regulated in accordance with the terms and conditions of any licence granted by the Minister.

### **SCHEDULE**

That part of the forest area declared in the First Schedule to Proclamation No. 44 of 1932 to be a forest area, namely, the following, all land between high water and low water marks (ordinary spring tides) on the mainland and islands adjacent to the coast from the mouth of the northern Kilifi River in the north to Ras Ngomeni in the south, excluding any areas that lie within the foregoing boundaries which may have been or may be declared private property under the Land Titles Ordinance, or which are subject to grants from the Crown.

In the foregoing description the centre of the course of the northern Kilifi River is to be understood as forming the boundary.
