

FORESTS (KAMBA) RULES

Cap. 176
(1948),
Sub. Leg.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Forests (Kamba) Rules.
2. The Chief Conservator may sell to Africans of the Kamba Land Unit for their own use but not for sale, trade or barter round poles when available from the forest areas within the said unit at the rate of-
 - (a) when the basal diameter is 2 in. to 4 in., one cent per two running feet or part thereof:
 - (b) when the basal diameter is 4 in. to 6 in., one cent per running foot or part thereof: and
 - (c) when the basal diameter is 6 in. to 8 in., three cents per two running feet or part thereof.
