Provisions on qual÷ty control of domestically circulated foodstuff

Based on: Decree No. 45/CCM, dated 3/6/91, of the Council of Ministers on the establishment of the Food and Medicine Control Committee.

Therefore, the Food and Medicine Control Committee issues the following provisions:

#### <u>Part I</u> <u>General principles</u>

- Article 1: These provisions aim at managing and controlling the sold in the values rocarities of the country for safe consumption.
- Article 2: In view of such purpose, all distribution services and businesses must ensure their food products' quality towards the consumers and the law.

# Part II Rights and obligations of authorizing authorities

- Article 3: The FMCC is the sole state organization with the authority to control and certify the quality of sold and serviced food products. Individuals or organizations conduction service and distribution businesses must register their products' quality with the FMCC beforehand.
- Article 4: Obligations of the FMCC.

The FMCC has the duty to conduct ordinary and special control and inspection of all food products at various places of sale, service, storage, markets, shops and others throughout the country. When necessary, officers will collect food samples for new analysis and quality control.

## Part III Rights and obligations of sellers and sirtibutors

- Article 5: Obligations of businessmen.
  - 5.1 Individuals or organizations distributing food products must be in possession of quality certificates both from the prodution and sale sites.
  - 5.2 Circulated foodstuff must wear labels established by the FMCC.
- Article 6: Retail sellers producing and selling as full and semi-occupation, for example: congee rice soup, chinese soups, drinks, ice cubs, icecreams, siryps, alcohol, meat, fish, vegetable, fruits and others, do not have the obligation to register or obtain permits from the FMCC, but must stand under the food quality control of the FMCC and abide by Article 08 to Article 13 of Part 5.

### Part IV Professional service fees

Article 7: Owners of sold and serviced food products must pay professional service fees for quality analysis and control according to the legications No. 198/FMC, dated 25/10/91, on service fees attached herewith)

### <u>Part V</u> Restrictions

- Article 8: All food distributing and servicing organizations, whether state or private, are forbidden as follows:
  - Non-fresh and spoiled food
  - Low quality food
  - Food displaying no label (to be established by the FMCC)
  - Synthetic food
  - Spoiled raw material
- Article :9 Colourings are forbidden, except for food colourings, and among these, only those officially authorized (recommendations attached herewith).
- Article 10: It is forbidden to use saccharin (as replacement of sugar) food and drinks.
- Article 1t It is forbidden to use preservative and antimushroom subsance ) in food and drinks, except for those
  authorized by the FMCC (recommendations attached herewith).
- Article 12: It is forbidden to use narcotic drigs and psychotic

substances in rood and drinks (marijuana, cafein and others ...).

Article 13: It is forbidden to use poisonous material in drinks, such as flint, insecticide,

#### <u>Part VI</u> <u>Penalties</u>

- Article 14 Any state or private organization transgressing these provisions will be warned, penalized, confiscated or prosecuted as provided by the laws.
  - 14.1 In case products are already sold, and consumers' health has been endangered and others... owners of such products will assume all compensations depending on the case.
- Article to Towards officials, whether professional and technical, if any individual or work team displaying dishonesty in production and their authority, such as:
  - receiving bribes
  - collusion with traders
  - Concealing the truthfor their personal interest will be warned, removed from their posts and prosecuted as provided by the laws.

### Organization and implementation

- Article 16: All distributing, selling, servicing state, private domestic or foreign organizations and individuals must strictly implement these provisions.
- Article 17: These provisions are effective from the day they are approved by the Prime Minister and promulgated.
