## **Regulations Regarding the State Fee for Registration of Circus Animals, Animal Acts, Venue Register for a Circus and Animal Act**

*Issued pursuant to  
Section 10, Clause 13 of the  
Animal Protection Law*

1. These Regulations prescribe the amount of the State fee and the payment procedures for the registration of a circus animal, an animal act, a venue register for a circus and animal act.

2. The State fee shall be paid in the following amount:

2.1. for registration of each circus animal and animal act or the aggregate of all bird or rodent specimens (hereinafter - animal) - LVL 1;

2.2. for venue register for animal act - LVL 25.

3. A person shall indicate the following information in the payment order of the State fee for registration of an animal:

3.1. the given name, surname and personal identity number (for a natural person) or the name and registration number (for a legal person) of the circus operator;

3.2. animal species and number; and

3.3. the amount of payment.

4. A person shall indicate the following information in the payment order of the State fee for venue register for a circus and animal act:

4.1. the given name, surname and personal identity number (for a natural person) or the name and registration number (for a legal person) of the circus operator;

4.2. the time and address of venue; and

4.3. the amount of payment.

5. The State fee shall be paid before the receipt of the service, using non-cash payment (by transfer) or in cash.

6. The State fee shall be transferred into the State basic budget.
