

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 53 OF 1990

Agricultural Marketing (Import of Sorghum) Regulations, 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of the Agricultural Marketing Act 1967, I, A. 26 of 1967

Evaristus Rets'elisitsoe Sekhonyana

Minister of Agriculture, Cooperatives and Marketing make the following regulations:

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Marketing (Import of Sorghum) Regulations, 1990 and shall come into operation on the date of their publication in the gazette. Citation and Commencement

2. In these regulations,
 - "Principal Secretary" means the Principal Secretary for the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperatives and Marketing;
 - "Marketing Officer" means the Agricultural Marketing Officer;
 - "sorghum" means the dry threshed ripe grain seed of milo, karif, feterica, hegari and hybrid derivatives of caffrorum;
 - "sorghum product" means sorghum meal or sorghum malt.Interpretation

3. (1) No person shall import into Lesotho sorghum or sorghum products without a permit. Import permits
 - (2) The Principal Secretary shall be responsible for the issue of the permit.
 - (3) A person may apply to the Principal Secretary or a Marketing Officer for the permit.

4. (1) The permit shall be valid only in the district in which it was issued. Validity of permit
 - (2) The permit shall be valid for a period not exceeding one month from the date of issue.

5. (1) The Principal Secretary may designate ports of entry through which sorghum or sorghum products may be imported into Lesotho. Ports of entry into Lesotho
 - (2) A person may import sorghum or sorghum products only through ports of entry specified in the permit.

6. The Principal Secretary may withdraw a permit where a person contravenes any provision of these regulations. Withdrawal of permit

7. A Marketing Officer may seize illegally imported sorghum or sorghum products found in traders' shops or wholesalers' stores. Seizure of illegally imported sorghum

Penalty and
disposal

8. (1) A person who contravenes any provision of these regulations commits an offence and is liable,

(a) on first conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred maloti or imprisonment for a period not exceeding 3 months or to both;

(b) on second and subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding six hundred maloti or imprisonment for a period not exceeding 6 months or to both.

(2) Where a person is convicted under sub-regulation (1), in addition to any other penalty, the court may order that any sorghum or sorghum product which relates to the conviction shall be forfeited to the Crown.
