RULES ON INLAND ANGLING

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Rules on Inland Angling (hereinafter 'the Rules') set out objects, gear, techniques and an angling system, a procedure for organising angling, and regulate other activities related to inland angling.

2. The Rules do not apply to angling in the Baltic Sea, private reservoirs and ponds. The Rules apply to angling in other private water bodies to the extent specified in the Procedure for angling in inland water bodies under private ownership and joint and several ownership of the state and natural or legal persons, approved by Order No. D1-771 of the Minister of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania of 25 September 2012 (*Official Gazette*, 2012, No. 113-5748).

3. For limited fishing, the Rules apply to the extent specified in legislation on limited angling. Angling in protected areas is regulated also by the regulations, individual protection regulations and management plans of these areas.

II. DEFINITIONS

4. For the purposes of these Rules:

4.1. 'Crayfish trap' is a trap measuring not more than 100 cm in length and not more than 50 cm in width;

4.2. 'One fishing event' is an angling or limited fishing event from the person's arrival at the fishing site to the end of the fishing event;

4.3. 'Angler's permit' is an angling permit granting a natural person the right to fish in state-owned water bodies which are not under a lease and in which angling is not prohibited under legislation on angling and such fishing requires no angler's card;

4.4. 'Angler's card' is an angling permission granting the right to fish in the specified state-owned water body in which limited fishing is conducted.

5. Other terms used in these Rules have the meanings assigned to them by the Law on Angling, the Law on Fisheries and other legal acts of the Republic of Lithuania.

III. ANGLING SYSTEM

6. Not more than 5 crayfish traps or crayfish nets and 4 other items of angling gear may be used at a time. When fishing from one boat, one angler may not use more than 2 fishing rods at a time, except where angling takes place from a boat held in place by an anchor or other means. The total number of hooks used at a time may not exceed 6 units, except smelt fishing where the total number of hooks may be 12. When fishing smelt with 12 hooks in open water, all other fishes of any species, excluding flounder, must be released to the same water body immediately. A double or triple hook is deemed to be one hook. The number of traps and nets for catching spiny-cheek and signal crayfish is not limited; catching these crayfish by hand or landing net is also allowed.

However, all noble and narrow-clawed crayfish caught during such fishing must be released into the same water body immediately.

7. During one fishing event, it is allowed to catch 1 wels catfish, not more than 2 asp or common barbels, 3 pikes, eels, brown trout or graylings, not more than 5 burbot, zander, chubs or ide (the total number of fish specified in this paragraph may not exceed 5 units), not more than 50 crayfish (except spiny-cheek and signal crayfish for which the catch quantity and size are not limited). The total weight of fish per one fishing event, not specified in this paragraph but allowed for fishing, may not exceed 5 kg, and in the Curonian Lagoon 7 kg, excluding the weight of the last caught fish, smelt for which the allowed quantity is not limited, and except cases where the weight of one fish exceeds the quota set out in this paragraph. Each person engaged in angling must keep his/her catch separated from other persons' catch. The above-specified catch weight excludes the fish included in the List of invasive species in Lithuania approved by Order No. D1-433 of the Minister of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania of 16 August 2004 approving the List of invasive species in Lithuania and repealing some orders of the Minister of Environment (hereinafter 'the List of invasive species'), and the fish that were caught live and were released into the water body immediately. Fish held in keep net or by any other means restricting their free movement in water pool are included in fishing quota. For all fish caught in breach of legislation on angling, the damage for fish resources is being counted regardless of their vitality.

8. It is allowed to catch small fish and chironomides as bait using one hand net for bait catching that measures not more than 1 meter in diameter and has not more than 10 mm mesh. During one fishing event, one angler is allowed to catch not more than 30 juvenile crucian carps, roaches, perches and other fish species, except predatory fish, the fish listed in paragraphs 12.1 to 12.3 of these Rules and the fish entered on the List of protected fish and crayfish species approved by Order No. 84 of the Minister of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania of 31 March 1999. In water bodies under a lease, catching of chironomides may be performed only with an agreement of the lessee of a water body, holding his issued fishing permit, with a right to catch chironomides indicated.

9. During angling contests, the restrictions referred to in paragraph 7 and the prohibition stipulated in paragraph 11.1 of these Rules may be ignored if a written approval has been obtained from:

9.1. the Regional Environmental Protection Department of the Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter 'the Regional Environmental Protection Department'), in the administrative territory of which the water body is located, in state-owned water bodies not under a lease;

9.2. the lessee of a water body, in state-owned water bodies under a lease. The lessee of a water body must agree the fishing conditions with an appropriate Regional Environmental Protection Department;

9.3. the Directorate of a state park (in addition), if the water body is located in the territory of a state park.

10. The prohibited activities are as follows:

10.1. Fishing by using electrical energy, poisonous or explosive substances, firearms or pneumatic weapons (except spearguns), aqualungs and other autonomous breathing devices; shooting fish with spearguns from a boat or when paddling or walking on the shore; fishing by the stabbing, hooking (when a

fish is caught on the hook by any part of the body, except the head) or striking technique; fishing when exceeding the number of allowed fishing gear items or hooks more than two times; fishing with non-recreational fishing gear or removing it from water pool; fishing in breach of paragraph 10.3 of these Rules; fishing in sites where it is prohibited or prohibited at specified time; fishing with gear and baits which are prohibited to use in that site at specified time or without right obtained under the procedure prescribed by legislation to fish with such gear or baits; fishing in breach of paragraphs 12.1, 12.2 and 12.3 of these Rules; fish grayling, brown trout or salmon with baits of natural origin, use crayfish traps or crayfish nets for catching fish, other than noble, narrow-clawed, spiny-cheek, and signal crayfish (hereinafter 'the prohibited fishing techniques');

10.2. Keeping or carrying fish spears, long lines and non-recreational fishing gear (hereinafter 'the prohibited fishing gear'), except where such gear is used for commercial or special fishing under the procedure prescribed by legislation or for the purpose of science and education;

10.3. Removing long lines or non-recreational fishing net gear from water and taking out fish from them. On noticing any prohibited fishing gear in a water body, not labelled as set out in the Procedure for the labelling of fishing gear approved by Order No. D1-383 of the Minister of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania of 29 July 2005 (hereinafter 'the Rules on the Labelling of Fishing Gear'), persons must, without removing such fishing gear from water, report the fact to officers of the environmental state control: to Information reception and management centre of State environment protection agency Tel.: 8(5) 273 2995 or General support centre Tel.: 112;

10.4. Using as bait animals entered on the List of invasive species and fish, listed in paragraphs 12.1-12.3 of these Rules;

10.5. Engaging in underwater fishing without a distinctively visible buoy at the site of fishing; for underwater fishing, using double or forked spear tips for fish other than eels;

10.6. Being in water bodies or less than 25 m from them with angling gear, if fishing in those water bodies is prohibited or prohibited at that time, or without an angling permit that grants the right to fish in that particular water body, or without the right to fish free of charge; also being in water bodies or less than 25 m from them with spearguns intended for underwater fishing, if underwater fishing is prohibited in those water bodies;

10.7. Trading in fish from angling and their products;

10.8. Being on ice of water bodies where the condition of ice threatens human lives or health, the ice cover is thin or the Lithuanian Hydrometeorological Service under the Ministry of Environment has reported ice conditions likely to threaten human lives or health.

11. Fishing is prohibited:

11.1. Without an angling permit that grants the right to fish in that particular water body, except persons holding the right to fish free of charge. On 6 July and 15 August all persons have the right to fish free of charge in all state water bodies where angling is not prohibited and limited fishing is not organised, and in the water bodies of the Nemunas Delta Regional Park where angling is not prohibited;

11.2. Using prohibited fishing gear or techniques;

11.3. Using rubber tapes longer than 20 cm attached to angling gear;

11.4. For noble and narrow-clawed crayfish, using gear and techniques other than crayfish traps and crayfish nets. Fish of any species, caught with this gear, must be released into the same water body immediately;

11.5. Using bait of natural origin for grayling, brown trout and salmon;

11.6. For asps using more than two baits;

11.7. At a distance of less than 10 m from non-recreational fishing net gear labelled under the procedure laid down in the Rules on the Labelling of Fishing Gear;

11.8. In fish passes (special installations for fish migration over dams) and closer than 100 m downstream spillways (dams) of reservoirs;

11.9. On ice without gear that facilitates self-rescue in case of breaking through the ice - a pair of ice picks with a flexible connection;

11.10. From 20 April to 20 May, in the 400 m zone around the Dabinta Peninsula in Kaunas Reservoir;

11.11. From 1 January to 20 April, using live fish as bait (this prohibition does not apply to fishing in the Curonian Lagoon, as well as to using pieces of fish);

11.12. From 15 December to 15 January, on the River Nemunas from the mouth of the River Gėgė to the bridge of Jurbarkas, and on the River Nevėžis from its mouth to the bridge of Babtai during the hours of darkness from sunset to sunrise (according to calendar entries);

11.13. All the year round in water bodies listed in Annex 1 to these Rules;

11.14. From 16 September to 15 October, on river sections specified in Annex 5 to these Rules;

11.15. From 1 October to 31 December, on the rivers listed in Annex 2 to these Rules, except the fishing of spiny-cheek and signal crayfish with crayfish traps and crayfish nets;

11.16. From 16 September to 15 October, without an angler's card or the right to fish free of charge on the river sections specified in Annex 3 to these Rules, except the fishing of spiny-cheek and signal crayfish with crayfish traps and crayfish nets;

11.17. From 16 October to 31 December, on the river sections specified in Annex 4 to these Rules, except the fishing of spiny-cheek and signal crayfish with crayfish traps and crayfish nets;

11.18. From 16 September to 15 October, from sunset to sunrise (according to calendar entries) on the river sections specified in Annex 3 to these Rules;

11.19. From 1 July to 1 November on the river sections specified in Annex 6 to these Rules;

11.20. From 16 September to 15 October in River Neris from Šilas road bridge to Valakupiai bridge in Vilnius using fishing gear and baits dedicated for catching predatory fish or Salmonids.

12. It is prohibited to fish:

12.1. The following fish species:

12.1.1. Common nase (*Chondrostoma nasus*);

12.1.2. European weatherfish (*Misgurnus fossilis*);

12.1.3. Sea lamprey (*Petromyzon marinus*);

12.1.4. European brook lamprey (*Lampetra planeri*)

12.1.5. Lamprey ammocoetes;

12.1.6. Atlantic sturgeon (*Acipenser oxyrinchus*);

12.1.7. Other aquatic animals entered on the List of protected animal, plant and fungi species of the Republic of Lithuania approved by Order No. 504 of the Minister of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania of 13 October 2003, if no angling card has been issued for their fishing;

- 12.2. The following fish species without an angler's card:
- 12.2.1. Salmon (*Salmo salar*);
 - 12.2.2. Brown trout (*Salmo trutta trutta*);
 - 12.2.3. European whitefish (*Coregonus lavaretus*);
 - 12.2.4. European river lamprey (*Lampetra fluviatilis*);
- 12.3. Fish and crayfish smaller than the following sizes (fish are measured from the tip of the snout to the end of the caudal fin, and crayfish are measured from the tip of the rostrum to the end of the telson):
- 12.3.1. Wels catfish (*Silurus glanis*) 75 cm;
 - 12.3.2. Salmon (*Salmo salar*) 65 cm;
 - 12.3.3. Brown trout (*Salmo trutta trutta*) 65 cm;
 - 12.3.4. Asp (*Aspius aspius*) 55 cm;
 - 12.3.5. Burbot (*Lota lota*) 45 cm;
 - 12.3.6. Common barbel (*Barbus barbus*) 45 cm;
 - 12.3.7. Zander (*Sander lucioperca*) 45 cm;
 - 12.3.8. Pike (*Esox lucius*) 45 cm;
 - 12.3.9. Grayling (*Thymallus thymallus*) 30 cm;
 - 12.3.10. Brown trout (*Salmo trutta fario*) 30 cm;
 - 12.3.11. Chub (*Leuciscus cephalus*) 30 cm;
 - 12.3.13. Ide (*Leuciscus idus*) 30 cm;
 - 12.3.14. Tench (*Tinca tinca*) 25 cm;
 - 12.3.15. Carp (*Cyprinus carpio*) 40 cm;
 - 12.3.16. Grass carp (*Ctenopharyngodon idella*) 40 cm;
 - 12.3.17. Bighead carp (*Artisticichtys nobilis*) 40 cm;
 - 12.3.18. Noble crayfish (*Astacus astacus*) 10 cm;
 - 12.3.19. Narrow-clawed crayfish (*Astacus leptodactylus*) 10 cm;
- 12.4. The following fish and crayfish species in the specified periods:
- 12.4.1. Pike (*Esox lucius*) from 1 February to 20 April;
 - 12.4.2. Zander (*Sander lucioperca*) from 1 March to 20 May;
 - 12.4.3. Asp (*Aspius aspius*) from 1 April to 15 May;
 - 12.4.4. Grayling (*Thymallus thymallus*) from 1 March to 15 May;
 - 12.4.5. Brown trout (*Salmo trutta fario*) from 1 October to 31 December;
 - 12.4.6. European whitefish (*Coregonus lavaretus*) from 1 October to 31 December;
 - 12.4.7. Burbot (*Lota lota*) from 15 December to 15 January;
 - 12.4.8. Vimba bream (*Vimba vimba*) from 15 May to 15 June;
 - 12.4.9. Noble and narrow-clawed crayfish from 15 October to 15 July;
 - 12.4.10. Common bream (*Abramis brama*) from 20 April to 20 May in the water bodies in the territory of the Nemunas Delta Regional Park;
 - 12.4.11. Wels catfish (*Silurus glanis*) from 1 November to 1 April.

13. Caught fish and crayfish smaller than those set out in paragraph 12 and fish whose fishing is prohibited or prohibited at that time must be released into the same water body immediately.

14. All prohibitions referred to in paragraphs 11 and 12 apply both on the first and the last day of the specified period. If the first day of a prohibition falls on a weekend or public holiday, the prohibition becomes effective the next day after that weekend or public holiday. A prohibition does not apply on the last day of the prohibition if this day falls on a weekend or public holiday.

15. Underwater fishing is prohibited in State water bodies, excluding::

15.1 limited underwater fishing in these water bodies:

15.2. cases indicated in paragraph 16 of these Rules.

16. Lessees of water bodies may allow underwater fishing after entering this fact in the terms of the angling permit, if such state water bodies are outside the recreational functional priority zones set in the plans of state parks and their zone boundaries approved by resolutions of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania.

IV. FINAL PROVISIONS

17. Persons engaged in angling must:

17.1. When fishing, have with them and, upon request of environmental state control officers, part-time environmental inspector or other officials who under the law are authorised to carry out environmental state control, provide an angling permit (the number of an electronic angling permit) that grants the right to fish in that water body, and a document allowing to establish the person's identity, or a document confirming the right to fish free of charge;

17.2. Ensure the cleanliness of the fishing site (except when constantly changing fishing location, fishing underwater or on boat):

17.2.1. Before starting to fish and during fishing, collect all municipal waste present within a radius of 5 m from the fishing site into bags or other containers;

17.2.2. After fishing, remove the collected municipal waste to municipal waste collection containers;

17.3. Upon catching or finding any tagged fish, notify the Regional Environmental Protection Department of the Ministry of Environment or the Fisheries Service under the Ministry of Agriculture of this fact. The notification must specify the place, date and time of catching the fish, fishing gear and bait used to catch the fish and the tag number. If the fish is not released into the water body, the weight, length (L) (from the tip of the

snout to the end of the caudal fin) and sex of the fish must be indicated and the tag must be enclosed. Other information (mechanical damages noted, signs of disease, parasites, etc.) must be specified as well.

18. Persons in breach of these Rules must compensate damage to the fish stock calculated in accordance with the Procedure for the calculation of damage inflicted on fish stocks approved by Order No. D1-280 of the Minister of Environment of the Republic of Lithuania of 21 May 2009.

19. If no owner or user is present near recreational fishing gear, the gear may be taken away and held by environmental state control officers or other officials authorised by the law until the owner or user is identified.
