

MALAYSIAN PALM OIL BOARD (COMPOUNDING OF OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2005

PU(A) 519/2005

IN exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 78(1)(i) of the Malaysian Palm Oil Board Act 1998 [Act 582], the Minister makes the following regulations:

31 December 2005

1. Citation and commencement

(1) These regulations may be cited as the **Malaysian Palm Oil Board (Compounding of Offences) Regulations 2005**.

(2) These Regulations come into operation on 1st January 2006.

2. Compoundable Offences

The offences under the Act and regulations that are specified in the Schedule may be compounded by the Director-General under subsection 71(1) of the Act.

3. Payment

(1) Person who accepts the offer to compound an offence must pay the amount specified in the offer in cash or by money order, postal order, cashier's order, banker's cheque or bank draft made payable to the Director-General of the Malaysian Palm Oil Board and crossed with the words "Account Payee Only".

(2) Payment may be made at any office of the Board or by post.

(3) An official receipt for the payment shall be issued to the person to whom the offer to compound was made.

4. Revocation

The Palm Oil Industry (Compounding of Offences) Regulations 1982 [P.U. (A) 397/82] is revoked.
