THE MAURITIUS CANE INDUSTRY AUTHORITY ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 63 of the Mauritius Cane Industry

Authority Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the Mauritius Cane Industry Authority (Delivery of Canes for Production of Juice) Regulations 2016.

2. In these regulations -

“Act” means the Mauritius Cane Industry Authority Act.

3. An application for an authorisation under section 24 of the Act to deliver canes to a person engaged in the production of fresh juice for direct consumption shall be made in such form as the Authority may determine and shall be accompanied, subject to regulation 4(3), by the appropriate fee specified in the Schedule.

4. (1) The Control and Arbitration Committee may, with the approval of the Minister, grant an

authorisation to a planter to deliver canes to a person engaged in the production of fresh juice for direct consumption.

(2) An authorisation granted under paragraph (1) shall be subject to such conditions as the Authority may determine.

(3) The fee shall be refunded where authorisation is not granted.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 10 June 2016.
