An Act

To amend the State Lands Act so as to permit the sale by private contract of those portions of State Land on which ex-CHA Housing Estates have been built

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the State Lands (Amendment) Act 2007.

2. Interpretation

In this Act –

“principal Act” means the State Lands Act.

3. Section 5 of principal Act amended

Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by adding after subsection (2), the following new subsection –

- (3) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this Act, where the owner of a house standing on a portion of State Land, which was built as part of a Housing Estate commonly known as an ex-CHA Housing

Estate, is willing to buy the portion of land, the Minister may sell it to him by private contract at the price of 2000 rupees.
