| <p>*1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Potato (Cultivation) Ordinance.</p> | <p>Short title.</p> |
| <p>2. The Minister responsible for agriculture shall have power to make, and when made, amend, vary or revoke regulations for all or any of the following purposes:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(a) for forbidding the importation of seed-potatoes not conforming to requirements;</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(b) for providing for the proper cultivation of potatoes;</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(c) for regulating the exercise of the trade of potato-broker and for fixing the brokerage fees.</p> | <p>Power of Minister responsible for agriculture to make regulations.

| <p>3. Any person who commits a breach of any regulation made under this Ordinance shall be guilty of a contravention and shall be liable on conviction to the punishments established in the Criminal Code for contraventions.</p> | <p>Offences and penalties.
